In recognition of the value international Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) graduates bring to Western Australia (WA), the Western Australian Premier's WACE Bursary will be provided to support successful offshore WACE graduates who commence studies onshore at a WA university.

The bursary funding is to be used by the successful applicants to reimburse expenses related to travelling to WA, cost of living, and can be used to contribute towards education expenses.

Applicants found provisionally successful for award of the Western Australian Premier's WACE Bursary will be required to provide a [Confirmation of Enrolment \(CoE\)](#) from their selected WA University or Tertiary pathway provider, have attendance onshore in WA confirmed past the census date by the WA University or Tertiary pathway provider, provide evidence of their Australian bank account, execute an agreement with the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation, and pass verification checks, made by the Department prior to any payment being made.

Applications for the Western Australian Premier's WACE Bursary are open and will be awarded on a rolling basis. Please see the guidelines for more information on dates.

- **Stream One (University):** This stream is available to students who intend to enrol or are enrolled in one of the five Western Australian universities who demonstrate excellence in academics, extracurricular activities, community service, leadership and/or entrepreneurial thinking. The scholarship amount is a one-off payment of **\$20,000**.
- **Stream Two (Tertiary pathway provider):** This stream is available to students who intend to enrol or are enrolled at a Western Australian education provider in a pathway to university program who demonstrate excellence in academics, extracurricular activities, community service, leadership and/or entrepreneurial thinking. Funding will be distributed in a one-off \$5,000 payment while the student undertakes their pathway studies and a further one-off payment of \$15,000 once the student has commenced studies at their chosen university. The total scholarship amount totals **\$20,000**.

*Tertiary provider: are defined as educational institutions that offer qualifications above the secondary school level. This includes vocational education institutes, Technical and Further Education (TAFE) colleges, and private colleges. Courses include Bachelor's degree, advanced diplomas, and diplomas etc.

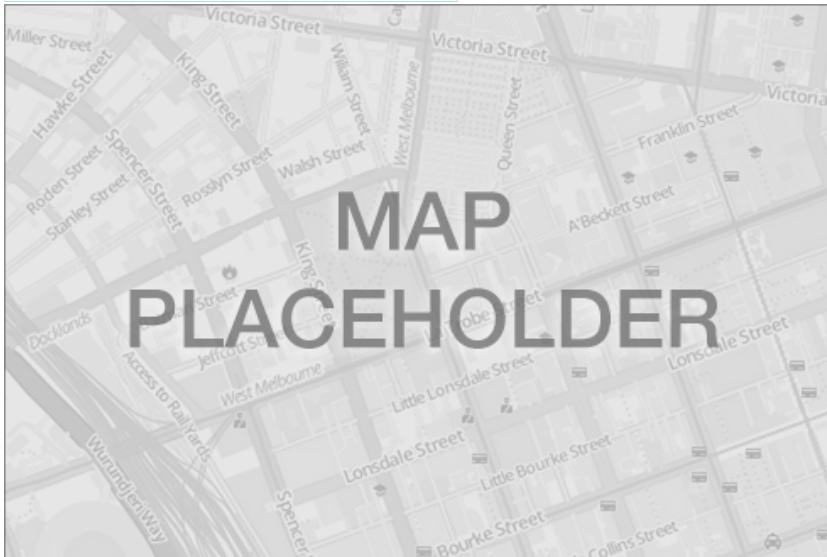

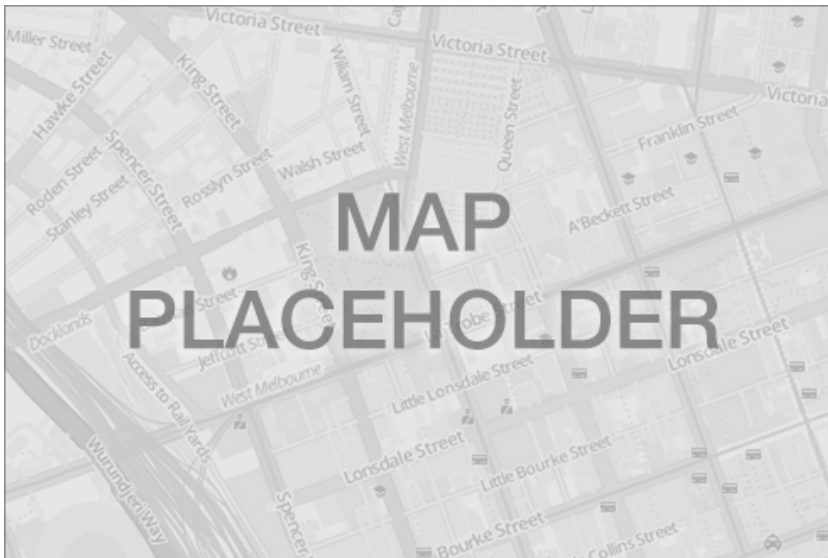
